As part of a global community spanning 70+ countries, ASSITEJ Denmark promotes the artistic, cultural, and democratic value of high-quality performing arts and advocates for every child and young person's right to encounter meaningful artistic experiences.

The organisation's purpose is to strengthen a vibrant and internationally connected Danish performing arts sector by creating networks, developing collaborative projects, and facilitating the exchange of knowledge, artistic practices, and professional experiences across borders. ASSITEJ Denmark supports the international mobility of artists and organisations while increasing the visibility of Danish performing arts for young audiences internationally.

As a member-driven organisation, ASSITEJ Denmark is built on the belief that strong artistic communities grow through openness, generosity, and collaboration. The organisation offers its members access to an inspiring international network, artistic exchange programmes, professional development opportunities, and platforms for building partnerships and sharing expertise. By connecting local practice with global perspectives, ASSITEJ Denmark contributes to a diverse, sustainable, and forward-looking performing arts sector for and with children and young people.

A key part of this international engagement is ASSITEJ Denmark's active role in the **Nordic-Baltic ASSITEJ Network (NBAN)**, a regional collaboration between the eight Nordic and Baltic ASSITEJ centres. NBAN creates opportunities for artistic co-creation, professional exchanges, youth participation, residencies, workshops, and long-term partnerships across the region. Through this collaboration, ASSITEJ Denmark helps strengthen the Nordic-Baltic performing arts community while developing sustainable and inclusive models for creating and presenting performing arts for young audiences.
