Syddjurs Egnsteater is a producing theatre dedicated primarily to children, young people, and families. Situated in a rural municipality on the east coast of Jutland, we work in a region with few professional arts institutions and a strong need for accessible, high-quality cultural experiences. This context shapes our artistic practice and our commitment to bringing professional performing arts close to everyday life.

Our artistic focus lies in theatre for young audiences that explores the spatial possibilities of performance. We are particularly interested in works that create immersive worlds and transform landscapes, public spaces, schools, community venues, and other non-traditional settings into meaningful theatrical experiences. Rather than seeing space as a backdrop, we view it as an active artistic collaborator.

Working across a geographically diverse rural area has strengthened our interest in site-sensitive and space-creating performance practices. We seek collaborations with artists who are curious about how theatre can engage children through atmosphere, imagination, and the relationship between audience, place, and performance. Through local, national, and international partnerships, we aim to contribute to the continued development of contemporary performing arts for young audiences while remaining deeply connected to the communities we serve.
